George Of The Jungle

- TE **George Kittle** finished the night with 15 receipts. for 183 yds. and 1 TD, his 13th career TD and 9th career game with 100-or-more rec. yds.
- **Kittle** is the first TE in NFL history to register 15-or-more receipts. and 175-or-more yds. in a single game.
- **Kittle's** 15 receipts. are the most in a single game by a TE in franchise history and the most by any member of the 49ers since WR Terrell Owens registered 20 receipts. vs. Chi. (12/17/00).

Jet Cleared For Takeoff

- RB **Jerick McKinnon** registered 14 carries for 54 yds. and 1 TD to go along with 7 receipts. for 43 yds. through the air.
- **McKinnon** has registered at least 1 TD in each of San Francisco's first 4 games of the season [1 rec. TD vs. Arz. (9/13/20), 1 rushing TD at NYJ (9/20/20) & 1 rushing TD at NYG (9/20/20)]. With his rushing TD, he extended his career high for most consecutive games scoring a TD and became the first member of the 49ers since WR Jerry Rice in 1991 to score at least 1 TD in each of the team's first 4 games of a season.

Run On Over

- WR **Brandon Aiyuk** registered 2 receipts. for 18 yds. and saw his only rush of the game go for a 38-yd. TD, marking the 2nd TD of his career.
- With 1 rushing TD last week at NYG (9/27), **Aiyuk** is the 1st 49ers WR to record a rushing TD in back-to-back games since WR Deebo Samuel in 2019 [1 vs. LAR (12/21/19) & 1 at Sea. (12/29/19)]. **Aiyuk** joins WR Tyreek Hill (Weeks 15-16, 2016) & Samuel as the only WRs with rush TDs in consecutive games in the last 5 seasons.
- **Aiyuk's** 38-yd.TD run is the longest by a 49ers WR since WR Terrell Owens in 2002 [38-yd. TD run vs. Was. (9/22/02)].

Nothing Al-Shaair About Him

- LB **Azeez Al-Shaair** intercepted a Eagles QB Carson Wentz pass that was tipped by DT Javon Kinlaw, marking his 1st career INT.

He's Jonesin' For A Sack

- DL **D.J. Jones** brought down Wentz for a 7-yd. sack, his 2nd of the season 4th of his career.

Taylor-Made Sack

- CB **Jamar Taylor** sacked Wentz for his 1st sack of the season and the 1st full sack of his career. He now has 1.5 career sacks.

Meet At The QB

- DL **Arik Armstead** and DL **Kerry Hyder Jr.** combined to bring down Wentz. **Armstead** now has 1.5 sacks on the season and 20.5 in his career, and **Hyder Jr.** now has 2.5 on the season and 12.5 in his career.

**49ers Head Coach Kyle Shanahan

Opening comments:

“Alright, guys. Injuries, we had [DL Ezekiel] Ziggy [Ansah] had a bicep, he's out. Went out, probably will have to go to IR. [CB] K'Waun [Williams] had a knee sprain, did not return. We'll have to get that looked at tonight. Find out tomorrow. [LB] Fred [Warner] had a hand, he returned. [WR Dante] Pettis had a knee. He returned. Go ahead.”

When it came to the offensive the struggles, especially in the fourth quarter, how much of that was on QB Nick Mullens and how much was it on the pass protection?

“I think it was on everybody. That's a good front. They did that to the team they played last week. Some's on play calling, some's on Nick, some's on all of us. We've got to play better and all around.”

We haven't seen T Trent Williams struggle like that, certainly not here. Maybe not even in Washington. Any mitigating factors? Is he healthy? How do you explain his outing today?

“No, he's healthy. Just didn't have one of his best games. I'll see more when I watch the film tonight, but I thought as a whole, the entire offense struggled a little bit. Right when we did get some things going, it was really one weak link on each play that just got us in some bad situations and costs us some drives. So, expect him to do better and expect all of us to do better.”

On Nick's two interceptions, he threw it right to the guy. Obviously, he doesn't want to do that. What did he see and why did he make those throws?

“The first one, he just missed the throw. He's got to get it out there. Check it down to [FB Kyle Juszczyk] Juice beneath him. And then the one in the red zone, it wasn't a good play call. No one was open. Had a short edge and he needed to throw it away or take a sack, but threw it into double coverage. Just a bad decision, but he had no other choice on the play. He had to just take it.”

Did you try to get the ball to WR Brandon Aiyuk more and what did you think of that touchdown he had? It seems like it showed what he can do.

“I thought the touchdown was a hell of a play. It was a really good play. Thought we could get the first with the look we had, but for him to turn that into a touchdown was an unbelievable play. It seemed like he did some good things out there. I'll see more when I watch the tape, but when we went to him, I thought he thought he did his job.”

It seems like TE George Kittle has more of an affinity to be able to make himself available for catches more than he used to. Do you see that improvement from him?

“Just looking at the numbers of stuff, George had unbelievable game. Didn't realize it was like that and he got open a lot and when he didn't, he still was able to come down with the catch. I know that's something George has worked on for awhile and came through today for us in that way.”

Through the first three quarters, the receivers only had two catches. I would assume that the game plan was probably to get them to Kittle. Would you expect more from them typically than what happened tonight?

“Yeah, just how the game goes sometimes. I don't remember any times where - they had a couple of opportunities, we didn't get the play off. When you miss a few of those and you just miss a few catches when you had a chance to get it and it wasn't their fault I didn't go to them. And then you struggle on some drives, that's just what happens. I thought for the most part, a lot of them, when we did go to them, they did a good job, but it takes a whole offensive to get the ball to a receiver. Not just the receivers.”

Nick was, in his first two throws, WR Kendrick Bourne was open and then Juszczuk was open down the left side line. Was he just kind of a little bit off and maybe just slow throughout the evening?

“Yeah, it seemed that way a little bit, especially the second play and stuff. It seemed good in pregame warmups and stuff, but that happens. You started the play with two passes and miss both of them. Thought we'd give him a chance to get going, get in a little bit of a rhythm. Seemed like whenever we did, something else came up and just wasn't able to get him into much of a rhythm today. So, I know he had a tough challenge here going against that front and everything. But, I know and Nick knows, he can play better. Gave an opportunity for [QB] C.J. [Beathard] to come in and see C.J. did a good job with the reps he had.”

You mentioned about Ziggy Ansah, the bicep injury. Is that preliminary, is that a torn bicep, something that will require season ending surgery?

“That's what it sounded like. Everything that I've heard in there, sounds like that's going to happen. So, pretty sure we'll find that out. Confirm that tomorrow, but that's what it sounded like.”

After the last game, you said you expected that kind of performance. You expected a good win. Did you feel that way about this one or was there perhaps a chance this might've been a little bit of an emotional let down because of kind of the rally with the injuries and this one now you're back home after those two wins?

“I was worried about that a little bit on Monday and Tuesday. That kind of went away. I thought we had a good day of practice on Wednesday, not so good on Thursday, but I thought we came back and had a good Friday. I loved the energy of the guys at the hotel last night. I was expecting us to come out and play good. Missed a few at the beginning, just a couple of opportunities. When we did get it going finally and I thought we had kind of a bump there when we had the turnover in the red zone on that pick. That's an aggressive defense. It's hit or miss with those guys. Just the style they play with, the style their front is, the style of their coverages. We had a couple opportunities we missed. And then the other ones we went for, we got way too many negative plays. So, I wouldn't say I thought it was a let down of guys, just their energy or everything, but we definitely didn't play well today. Not to take anything away from Philly or anything, but just from an execution standpoint, the whole team playing together in terms of when one side is doing good, the other side does good also. I just didn't like the rhythm of our whole team today and we'll have to go back to the drawing board tomorrow.”

You stuck with RB Jerick McKinnon a lot more than you did last week. Why did you decide to do that and then how would you assess how the running game performed?

"I think that just happened because we didn't have as many long drives as we did last week. We had a lot more long drives last week where you get in a little bit of a flow with rotating the guys and then with the lead we had last week, I think we took Jet out most of the fourth quarter and let [RB] Jeff [Wilson Jr.] go. That was about it with that. The run game, so, so. I expected us to do better. There was a couple opportunities that I thought we had where I thought we could have gotten some big runs on and we just had one guy off here and there and ended up losing a few yards on them. So, I expect more out of our run game. It wasn't completely bad, but I expected us to do better than we did."

How optimistic are you about QB Jimmy Garoppolo's status this week?

"I'm not sure, totally. I didn't talk to him today about how it went. We'll see tomorrow when he comes in. I know he'll have a good workout here Monday and Tuesday, and hopefully he'll be good to go for Wednesday, but I'm not sure yet."

Why was it so hard to get into a rhythm for you tonight?

"Oh, that's a good question and I'm kind of wondering that myself. We had plenty of opportunities and I really just didn't execute. I feel like the way I'm feeling is pretty black and white right now. I just didn't execute and that's really all it comes down to. Three turnovers, 14 points for them off turnovers and that's really about it. Just didn't execute."

Can you take us through that final interception, what you saw, what went wrong on that play?

"We had a 14-yard stop route. The linebacker, I saw him, I knew he was getting under it, but the ball just didn't come off right. I was going to have to put it over him a little bit, but the ball just didn't come off right. It unfortunately went right to him. "

On the first interception down in the red zone, what did you see on that?

"Oh, it was rolling out to my right. I saw the defender in front of the crosser. I thought he could outrun him and so I tried to just lay it out in front. When the defender came from behind, he cut it off. It's an opportunity ball. It's a risky throw and that's what happens when you take unnecessary risks, especially down in the score zone."

You guys just came back from a two week road trip. Was energy at all an issue during the week, anything that you can point to that you can say, 'Well, we could kind of see this coming earlier in the week?'

"No, I don't believe so. I feel like we had a really good week of practice. Mentally, I felt really sharp. Throughout the week of practice, I thought we were working hard and executing well. Even during the game, the defense executed at a very high level. I feel like if I would have completed the passes, we would have executed at a very high level. So, no, I don't think that was an excuse."

Why weren't you able to connect with the receivers more often during the first three quarters, especially?

"I just didn't. I just wasn't as accurate as I needed to be and felt like we could have just taken advantage of some opportunities when they were there. Create a little bit of a rhythm. We were in some second and long, third and long situations and no drive was very rhythmic except the ones that we scored on. I need to execute better."

It seems like TE George Kittle isn't always open when you throw the ball to him, but he gets open eventually. He somehow maneuvers his body. Is that something new that you've seen from him?

"Is that new? No. I feel like even if he's covered, he's open. That's what he's very talented at, yards after catch. He did a great job of that tonight. He had a lot of YAC tonight, I feel like. So, it was awesome to get George back on the field and he definitely did his part."

What was the challenge like facing that Philadelphia defensive front today, particularly on the pressure coming up the middle?

"Yeah, they had a pretty good pass rush, but I thought our guys up front did a really good job, actually. I really wasn't too worried about the pressure and things like that. I felt pretty calm back there. Felt relaxed, felt focused, but we were aware of that coming in, but I thought our O-Line did a pretty good job."

Without getting many reps during training camp and the last couple of weeks, how are you so comfortable back there?

"Honestly, I just give credit to me being in my fourth year in the system. It's night and day compared to last time I was in there playing in the regular season. Just feels comfortable. You know, the more you go through the plays, the more you're in the offense. It just gets a lot more comfortable."

Like you said, this is your fourth year. How would you describe the state of this team right now? You guys came off two big wins in New York and then this is your second home loss.

"Yeah. I mean, no one is panicking. I think we're right, I mean, we're good where we're at. I mean, two losses, we're two-and-two right now. And, that's just the fact of the matter. We're a two-and-two football team and we've got Miami next week and all we've got to do is go to work this week and get back on a winning schedule. So, no one's panicking though."

Were you surprised to get the call there in the fourth quarter and did you really have much chance to warm up before you started, you had your first net?

"I wouldn't say I was necessarily, I mean, I guess I was a little surprised, but I wasn't like caught off guard by it. You prepare as if you're going to be in there playing. But, when [quarterbacks coach] Shane [Day], our quarterbacks coach, told me, he asked me if I was

warm and I'd been warming up throughout the game. I always do. And I told him, 'Yeah, I'm good.' And it was right after that the next, the kickoff, and then I was in there."

I'm just wondering about the intricacies of the clock management. Was it imperative that you guys try to score before the two-minute warning there, for that first score, was that something being talked about?

"Actually, no. We never really mentioned it. I mean, I had it in the back of my mind there was a, that stop clockage or like two minutes, nine seconds left and we knew the ball, when [WR Kendrick Bourne] KB, they reviewed and KB was down. We knew the clock was going to start, so we wanted to be on the ball and ready to snap it just so hopefully we score there, which we did. And then we still had the two-minute warning."

How would you describe that experience just from an emotional perspective, coming into a game with those sort of stakes in an empty stadium? What was that like?

"It felt great to be in there. It's been a while since I got my last real game reps. It's been over a year. It just felt good to be back in there and being there with the guys and taking some meaningful snaps. And that's really all I can say. It felt good."

Can you walk us through what you saw on the two-point conversion that you missed there and did you feel like you had a chance to run it in that maybe you missed there?

"Yeah, I mean, so that play we put it in this week and it was a zone read and then we were just trying to pop [TE] George [Kittle] the ball. He was going to sell like he was blocking and then hit George like real quick. And that's the way we repped it all week. Obviously, looking back on it now, I wish I would have ran it because it was incomplete. I think nine times out of 10, we make that play. We complete it and make that play. We just didn't make it there."

We talked about the decision to punt at the end of overtime last week and what message that sent. Were you trying to send a message with the decision to go for two in the first quarter? What went into that?

“My decision was to go. I'm not going to spend a lot of time on the why, I just elected to go. We executed the play and got the two.”

QB Carson Wentz wasn't perfect, but what did you think of his performance today? It was pretty gutty.

“Very good. He played, he played very well. He played inspired and led this football team tonight for the win. It might not have been perfect, but he gutted out several plays tonight and my hats off to him for just continuing to battle and continuing to stand in there and make some tough throws and some tough decisions. He did a nice job. More importantly though this was really a team effort and team win tonight.”

You always talk about the next man up mentality and in a ten second span WR Travis Fulgham made the big play and then LB Alex Singleton, who was only in the game because LB T.J. Edwards got hurt got the pick-six. Can you talk about those two guys particularly and them stepping up in such a big situation?

“In Travis's case he's been flashing in practice and obviously with the injuries at the position, to be able to get him up get him some work, I think he's got a good relationship with Carson on the football field. It's something that we can continue to build on his performance. I thought he already played well. We'll look at the tape on the ride home. In Alex's case, this guy is kind of the unsung hero. He's a four core special teams player, he's a backup role player on defense and he just battles. He comes to work every day, he's always in a great mood, he's excited, guys rally around him and I was happy for him to get that pick six, obviously the interception and then have it end in the end zone. Just a great play by him, but those two guys are well-deserved.”

What is it about this team that when you're up against it, adversity strikes, injuries are piling up, you guys always seem to find a way to respond, find a way to win and how does first place sound to you?

“Having played four games, first place sounds really good right now, but we have a long season ahead of us. Only the first quarter of the season is done and we've got a long road ahead. One game at a time mentality, but I want to tell you something these guys don't quit. It's a resilient group. I'm so happy to be able to coach and lead them. It doesn't matter what the adversity is, what they're faced with, these guys seem to rally around each other. This is a tough road game to come out here on the road traveling East coast to West coast, play on a Sunday night, it's tough. It's tough, but they seem to find a way and my hats off to them. I'm excited for those guys in the locker room.”

You touched on Alex Singleton already, but for your defense to get those three turnovers for the first time this season, what did it mean for the confidence of the defense to be able to get that ball rolling?

"It's something that we've talked about quite a bit here lately and being able to protect the football and then get the takeaways. Tonight we got the three takeaways, which was huge. They were critical parts of the game and that's what it takes to win games like this against good opponents. You need something to go your way and those were key moments for our defense. I thought the D-Line played really well, putting pressure on the quarterbacks to be able to cause some of those interceptions and then obviously the fumble. It's just a great effort and I'm excited for the defense to have gotten those takeaways."

Carson had 65 rushing yards and a touchdown last week, tonight he had 37 and a touchdown. Can his ability to make plays with his feet offset the recent struggles with accuracy and the fact that you have so many receivers hurt and is that something that you encouraged him to do or something that he just kind of took upon himself?

"Carson does a great job of taking off when he needs to and making plays with his legs. Some of it's by design and some of it's obviously part of the run game where he can keep it. We just have to make sure we're doing the right thing as far as protecting him. We don't want to put him in those situations where he's always taking a beating that way or being hit. But he was smart tonight. We encourage him to use his legs when he can, and then we continue to scheme plays when they're there for him. That's the part of the game tonight that he played real physical, played tough and that was good to see."

What went into your decision to go for it on fourth and four, rather than have K Jake Elliott kick a 55-yard field goal that would have potentially tied the game?

"In that situation there it was just a decision to go. We wanted to stay on the field. We needed to get that first down right there. I just decided to go and put the ball in our hands. Trust your players, trust the decision that I made and you just trust the call. The guys executed the play extremely well, got the first down and we stayed on the field."

You had a lot of moving parts in the offensive line tonight. How do you think the group performed overall and what went into the decision to have T Jordan Mailata kind of handle that left tackle spot today?

"Obviously the [T Jason Peters] JP injury. Jordan's been getting a lot of reps over there at left tackle and that's his spot. He's been comfortable there and we've been comfortable with him there. I thought overall he did some good things tonight. We'll take a look at the film and evaluate it on the way back. We had a few extra offensive linemen up today in this game because there are some guys battling through some things and I thought overall the offensive line played well. They played tough and that's what it takes. This is a good defense that they played, a good front, they're aggressive, they attack and I thought our offensive line with the moving pieces and parts that we had really stepped up and did well."

Following up on that, did you ever picture a scenario at this point in the season where you'd be down four offensive linemen, your top four wide receivers and still you'd would find a way to win tonight?

"You never think of those scenarios, you're always trying to think positively and not negatively, but it is what it is and we are where we are. My hats off to the guys in the locker room. They don't listen to the outside noise, they focus on each other, they battle every single day. They come to work every single day, they practice hard and they come out here and compete, that's all I can ask."

From your perspective, what was the biggest difference with your team tonight, compared to the first three games?

"Quite frankly, we didn't talk about this being a must win. We didn't feel the pressure of having to go out and perform coaches and players. We just owned it. We just took it upon ourselves to go out and execute and just rally and support each other. We knew we had some new guys in the lineup tonight and it was going to take all guys that were dressed in uniform to win this game against a fine opponent and that's what they did. They rallied, they battled, it wasn't pretty, but it doesn't matter. A win's a win in this league and they're hard to come by. For us to get the first one and get the feeling of that, it gives us a little juice, a little momentum, heading into this next week."

On the go ahead drive, the fourth down pass to WR John Hightower and then the touchdown pass to WR Travis Fulgham, can take us through those two plays?

"Coach had a great play call on the fourth down to get John open. John did a good job of creating separation and that was a huge play for us to keep that drive going and then just a couple plays later, the go-ball to Travis. Obviously a limited amount of time on task working with Travis, but that's something that he can do and do well. He tracks the ball well. When we broke the huddle, I told him to be ready on that one. We made a play and pretty impressive on how he not only caught the ball, but kept his feet in to get in the end zone. That was just huge night for us to rally around a bunch of different guys, new faces out there making plays."

We talked this past week about how what happened late last season with all the injuries that maybe that's something that could get you guys going again this week. How did that factor into the game plan? How did factor into your mentality when you were out there and preparing for this game?

"I think as far as the game plan went we kind of just did what we did. We had a game plan ready to go for that style of defense and we expected the guys to step up and make the plays when asked to and that's what we did. For me, as far as my preparation I didn't overthink anything. Guys were there and they're going make the play and I trust them. The guys did a good job all week of coming together and building this thing together. Obviously tonight it was just a huge team, everybody all around offense, defense, special teams making plays when they needed to."

How many times did you have the opportunity to rep that play with Travis in practice and what did you get to say to him afterwards in the locker room or on the sidelines?

"We repped that play once and it was just cool. When we broke the huddle, I told him to be ready. I've seen him with this team for a while now going up against our defense on scout team and what he does to our defense. And then watching him and seeing what he's capable of doing, I was just proud of him for coming out here tonight and making the plays."

Did you hit on that one at practice?

"We did. So we're two for two on that one."

Did you make a concerted effort to use your legs more tonight, because of the situation with your lack of weapon or starters that weren't in the game?

"No, I don't go into a game thinking it's time to scramble or anything. The pockets sometimes breaks down, but they do a good job in coverage. Sometimes they cover us up and I've to make a play. That's something really the last two weeks that I'm feeling good about. Guys are doing a good job at holding their blocks up front so when we can extend plays like you saw tonight, there's some big plays to be had down the field when things do break down like that."

You mentioned the guys up front. T Jordan Mailata, obviously his first start at left tackle and there are a lot of moving parts. T Lane Johnson was in and out with the ankle. I think T Jason Peters left for a little bit as well. How did that affect you? I know you have to look at the tape, but how do you think Jordan played in his first start?

"Like you said, we've got to watch the tape but, off the bat I feel like he did a great job. I'm so proud of him and [T] Jack [Driscoll] for stepping up when asked. It was one of the things where they didn't know who's going to play this week and where they were going to be. And then decided yesterday when Jordan signed and then how hard he's worked ever since he's been here to get this opportunity on Sunday Night Football. He did a great job. I think the whole O-Line did a great job against a really good D-Line over there. He held his own and did a great job. Obviously we'll watch the tape, but I'm just proud of him and really everybody for stepping up."

I know you played the end of last season with so many of your top receivers out, but did you ever envision having to do this again, not only with the receivers but without four offensive linemen?

"Yeah, you can't really make it up, the injuries and the situations that we've been put in. But that's the hand we're dealt and guys have been ready. They've been working their tail off for their moment when it comes. You saw tonight a bunch of guys making plays that maybe were on practice squad last week or different things and obviously the O-Line, a lot of young guys that have been filling in and stepping up and doing an amazing job. Hats off to the coaches for getting these guys ready, hats off to these guys for staying ready and being locked in the way they were for tonight."

Two weeks in a row, you've been running the ball a lot, but even when you're not running with the ball, you're moving around a lot, you're throwing on the run. How comfortable are you doing it? How much do you enjoy being on the move, creating, extending plays and making things happen?

"I love being on the move and extending plays, making things happen. I think it puts a lot of stress on the defense. Obviously, I have to be smart and know when to take my chances and

know when to throw the ball away. Especially with a team like tonight that plays a lot of zone coverage, when plays break down, they're out of position or guys are coming open down the field. When that happens there's a lot of big plays to be had when you do escape and move the pocket and we made a couple of them tonight."

It seemed like for so many drives tonight, you had to just inch the ball down the field and it was so painstaking, every mistake. Jordan Mailata had a lot of false start that killed a drive. Every mistake just seemed enormous. What was it like to overcome that? How much patience did you have to have to hang in through all that and get the points at the end?

"You have to be patient anytime you're going up against a good defense like that, not only a good defense, but the way they play. They're going to play discipline. They're going to make you move the ball underneath and just really earn it. They're not going to give up any big plays. We knew that coming into the game and we built the game plan around that. Like you said, obviously the mistakes and little things can add up in those certain drives, but guys made enough place to get the win tonight and I'm proud of them."
