**49ers Head Coach Kyle Shanahan

Opening comments:

"All right guys, injuries we had from the game: [DL] D.J. Jones had an ankle, didn't return. [OL Tom] Compton had a head, being evaluated for a concussion, did not return. And that's all we had."

For a lot of the game, it looked like it was very easy out there for Buffalo Bills QB Josh Allen. The question will come up, why not blitz him more? Why not put more pressure on him? What was sort of the thinking about the style of defense that you guys played today?

"Obviously, it didn't work out well. I know that we did blitz sometimes. When I get back to our hotel here in a second, I'll find out how much, but when we did blitz, he got away from it and made some big plays with some receivers running across the field. When we didn't, he just dinked and dunked it and got after us, too. Our defense has been, I think, carrying us all year and has played really good this year. They had a big challenge today. We didn't play our best on D. That's why we had to on offense and special teams and it was going to be one of those type games that was going to be a shootout and we missed a few. I think we had a chance to do it on offense, make this game similar to how New Orleans was last year. That's kind of the game that I thought was being dictated. They held onto the ball for a while. I thought when we had that drop on third down, we lost a little momentum, didn't get to touch it much and just got away from us."

What stings you the most about how you guys played offensively?

"Just that we needed to play our best and I think that we were very close to doing it. We just had a few things that didn't keep us out on the field and when you do that versus an offense and a quarterback like that who's playing the way they are and you don't get it back for a while, the game gets away from you. I think we needed to keep matching them and it was frustrating because I believe, not taking anything away from them, they did an awesome job, but I believe that we were capable of that. We had our times, which I think you saw at times, but we had to do it every time today and we didn't get that done."

Obviously, you can't measure it, but do you think your situation being there, the relocation, had anything to do with the way things went tonight?

"No, absolutely zero. Nothing to do with it all tonight."

What's your assessment of QB Nick Mullens' performance thus far?

"I thought he made some plays. You could see there at the end he made some plays. He can't make those turnovers that he had, can't have that false start that he had there at the inch yard line, but I thought he gave us a chance. With the way the whole team played altogether, he did need to play better because I think we had to play perfect in a few areas and by no means do I think he played perfect, but there's still stuff to improve on, but there were some good and bad things he did today."

What was your message to the team afterwards, particularly given what the loss did to your potential playoff hopes?

"Really just, we've got four more games that we can account for that we're in charge of and we've got to win all of them. I felt going into this game that, starting with the Rams, and I felt like this game was a playoff game for us. Then when you lose it, you just leave stuff up to other people. I know with our team right now, the only thing that we can count on and control is making sure we win the rest of these and that starts versus Washington next week. We've got a short week. I just want the guys to get back to this hotel. Don't plan on seeing any of them tomorrow. Coaches are going to get together and we're going to get ready for Washington, have the guys rehab. They still left a lot out there tonight, physically

and everything. So, hopefully spend tomorrow right and when they see us on Wednesday, we're coming ready to go versus Washington. It starts with the first game, but we know we've got to win all of these. So, we've got to focus on Washington and get that done and then look to the next week."

I know you've been dealing with it without DL Dee Ford and DL Nick Bosa for most of the year, but how difficult does it make it for your defense in a game when you can't get much pressure with just the front four?

"Extremely difficult. That's what we were built for and going into the season on, but that changed pretty early. I think we've done a great job adjusting and plenty of guys have been coming in and out and I think our guys have done an unbelievable job on defense this year. Coaches and players. So, I'm extremely proud of those guys for this year and how it's gone so far and I expect us to finish strong these next four games, but today wasn't our best day. We had a huge challenge. It's a very good team altogether, very good coaches, very good offense, very good quarterback. We knew all week we had a big challenge and there's a few mistakes we made that made it a lot easier for them, stuff we can do better, but this was, I think, a night where we had to really step it up on O and we didn't do that enough."

WR Deebo Samuel, he only had one carry for three yards up until the late third quarter. Why do you think you guys had such a hard time getting him involved until late?

"I think it was real tough in the first half with anyone. We went on that one long drive, which, I think we had like two passes or something on that first drive, but all runs. It was really important to us tonight to establish the run to start the game out to get that going. So, we didn't have a ton of passes in the first half and the ones that we called for him, we didn't get those coverages and they controlled the ball very well. So, we didn't have the number of plays either. Tried to, but we weren't out there long enough. Eventually we got it to him. I thought he did a good job in the plays we tried and got to him on, but when we didn't score there on the end and they returned that, then it kind of ended right there."

I realize you're focused more on your defense, but what was striking about Josh Allen to see him in person? What does he do well that jumps out at you?

"No different than what you see on tape. He's been doing it all year. He's big, can run, has a big arm, plays the position well, got a good scheme and he's got some good people around him."

A couple of injury questions. Is there any indication what type of ankle injury D.J. Jones has? And then during the telecast, ESPN reporter Lisa Salters said that she spoke with general manager John Lynch and that QB Jimmy Garoppolo and TE George Kittle had good workouts, promising workouts late this week. Does that improve their timeline at all as far as when they can come back?

"No, that's just him answering a question probably. I mean, those guys are working their tails off right now, but they're still part of the rehab, just trying to get back and be a part of this, but it's not anytime soon right now."

D.J. Jones, what type of ankle injury?

"He didn't come back and they're worried it possibly could be a high ankle. So, that's what we've got to look into. Obviously, we're hoping it's not."

What happened on the on that quarterback sneak?

“Yeah, we went on the silent cadence and I want a little bit too early. Trying to anticipate the snap count, I went a little bit too early. And didn't execute.”

Then Kyle Shanahan said he felt like the tonight had a chance to be one of those games that could be a shootout that you just have to kind of keep up with them that you left some plays on the field. For you personally, know you haven't seen the tape yet, but were there plays you felt like got away from you that prevented you from being able to kind of keep up?

“Yeah, I mean, I yeah, I mean, I definitely feel the same way as coach does. I feel like there was a lot of space in the field for us to attack. We had our opportunities to attack and we just did an execute as a group. I think the most important thing, people talk about big plays, but it's big plays at the right times. And that's one thing that I, and us as an offense, have to improve. Every game, every play in the game is the most important play. And you don't know when those moments are going to come but to extend drives to a flip the field, score touchdowns, every moment is key. And so, the execution level has to be higher.”

Kind of the theme on both sides of the ball, offense and defense were missed opportunities by both sides. Was there anything that you can put your finger on that prevented you all from executing?

“Well, no. Nothing in particular, no. I feel like we could have had a big game and we didn't. I don't think it was one thing. Just got to go back to work. Next week we're focused on the details and I'll just keep striving to get better. That's all you can do. And that's the mindset that you got to keep striving to get better and making plays at the right time.”

What's sort of your, how do you view the team's mindset now? What, what's the locker room like, particularly, knowing that the challenge of going through the rest of the season with a large part of it likely being in Arizona?

“Yeah. I mean, after the loss we're frustrated we. We really feel like we can be a better football team. So, we're all frustrated. But we know that this loss isn't going to break us. There's a lot of football left to be played. We get more opportunities and ready to get back to work for those opportunities. And I mean, this team is tough, as tough as it gets. And so, we're not going to back down. We embrace the challenge. We love the challenge, and that's what we're going to work and strive for.”

Getting WR Brandon Aiyuk back on the field this week, did you feel like you immediately had your timing down? I mean, he was out for a little while. Was that any part of the issue on the field tonight?

“No, I felt good. Brandon is an incredible football player and anytime we can get the ball in his hands, like we saw tonight, he can change our offense, change the game. I left a couple throws, low for him, which is very frustrating because I know what he can do after the catch. He's a great player and I thought he did his job tonight.”

When it comes to, when you see a quarterback that you're opposing have a big night, like Buffalo Bills QB Josh Allen did tonight, does that register where you're seeing some of it or are you too buried in your own playbook and talking to your coach to kind of appreciate it? Or kind of get I don't know, pumped up to try to match him?

“Yeah. I mean, as a quarterback, I was excited. I really felt like we could have put up a lot of points. I really do. I really feel like we could have put up a lot of points. We didn't execute enough consistently to

you know, match their success. But yeah, he did a great game or he had a great game. We knew he was a great player and he played at a really good high-level tonight. So, you've got to tip your hat off to them. And yeah, it's frustrating. I feel like I could play a lot better."

What are your thoughts on the way your defense was really able to hold that 49ers run game in check. It seemed like everybody was swarming to the edges to really keep things hemmed in to not let those backs escape. Can you just comment on the effort there?

"I thought it was big that we were able to establish a line of scrimmage set the edges. The players executed extremely well. There's some meat on the bone at the end of the game there, where we'd like to have gotten off the field. Those are some of the things we can learn from going forward."

Can you speak to the complete command that QB Josh Allen seemed to have from start to finish in this game?

"It was a well-executed game plan. [Offensive Coordinator] Coach [Brian] Daboll and his staff and Josh and our offense really did a nice job playing clean football. Josh going and finding his receivers on some on schedule and some off schedule plays as well. That was good to see. Then the drive before the half I thought was really at a high standard. It was truly elite, with the clock management there and the execution by the players."

Going back to Josh, what do you make of the way that he's continued to build and develop that chemistry with WR Stefon Diggs and WR Cole Beasley? I know we talk about it all the time, but it just seems like he continues to build that chemistry and that relationship?

"It's time on task. Between spending a little more time going through different looks and getting all the reps that they've gotten out to this point in the season. I'll also mention how he was getting the ball to the backs and the tight ends. I thought it was key how we just spread the ball around as well. The play where he played it over the middle, I thought was a phenomenal throw and catch and a big play for us at one moment, I think it was in the second quarter."

In the past, you've characterized wins in different ways. You've said that one win was the character win, another one was an emotional win for the city. First win on Monday night for this franchise since 1999, what does that say about the steps that this organization has taken and how would you characterize this one?

"I haven't given it much thought, all wins are good wins. I'm happy for, for our organization obviously, and happy for the fans. I'm sure everyone back in Buffalo stayed up late to watch it. Hopefully the kids got some rest and they can get up early tomorrow when they're supposed to get up."

You said earlier that there's some meat left on the bone there at the end of the game, but all in all, is this probably the closest thing to a complete four quarter game that you all have played so far this season?

"Yeah, it was. I'm always looking for more and I love the fact that our players are as well. We'll go back to the drawing board this week. I thought the takeaway by [CB] Tre[Davious] White was key down the stretch and how we answered when they scored in the fourth quarter. All good complimentary football pieces right there."

The team's struggles in the third quarter are documented, but what was it that made this third quarter different than some of them that we've seen in the past?

"I just think the players have a good level of awareness for it. They were fired up in the locker room at halftime to go back out there and put their stamp on this game in particular and us moving forward here."

How refreshing is it to see your quarterback poised and under control in those pressure moments?

"That's how he's wired. Our offense feeds off it and I just really appreciate the way he played the game tonight. He played the game in a very patient way when he needed to be patient. He took some shots when he needed to take some shots. I thought Coach Daboll called a great game and Josh, and the offense executed. There were some moments where we had some leakage, but I thought the offensive line was able to give him time for the most part."

How impressed were you with the way your team executed on a high level, on a national platform?

"We had a good week of practice. Players were in a good position mentally coming into the game. They were focused and ready to go. Even the backups were ready to go, which is great. When [G Jon] Feliciano went down, a couple of other guys went down, next guys came in and did a good job in there which was good to see."

What's your secret of getting your team ready so even to take a trip all the way out to Arizona for the second time this season, the guys have their legs, they look fresh and ready to play?

"That's a credit to them and a credit to our coaching staff. We've got good guys that come to work, ready to work, ready to learn, ready to improve on what they did the day before or the game before. I think that's the growth mindset. When you've got guys that are eager to learn and grow, I think that's a good quality for a football team."

What did you think of DT Justin Zimmer's play tonight? I saw you were giving him a little more time and he looked like he was trying to take advantage of it.

"It's all about what you do with the opportunity, right. He flashed on a couple plays last week, flashed again this week. I know there's some plays he wants back, just like last week. He's a young player that's only going to get better. He's wired the right way as well. He is an extremely hard worker and a good young man."

You've gotten progressively more aggressive since you've been here with fourth downs and end of half situations. How would you describe the way this team has evolved in that way?

"We try and be responsible with it. I don't think we just do it, to do it, it's calculated. Sometimes during the week and then obviously during the game, I think [Director of Research and Strategy] Dennis lock and [Assistant Wide Receivers/Game Management] Marc Lubick, my two assistants upstairs do a phenomenal job of working together and analyzing the game as we're going and evaluating the necessary areas. I know it makes my job easier."

What have you learned since you started being a coach to now, with those in-game decisions?

"I just think there's no substitute for experience. When you're a coordinator, you're not really analyzing the game and evaluating the game in that way and that light. I think that experience has helped all of us, including me. It's been a great teacher and let's just hope we continue do things at a high level in that area."

The 49ers are a physical team and the way your team matched that maybe with exceeded that, what does that do for them now and going forward with the type of games you're going to play and into playoff games?

"I think you've got to be able to play like that. This is a physical sport, you've got to be able to play physical. You've got to be able to control the line of scrimmage, win the line of scrimmage. I think for the most part tonight we did that on both lines, offensively and defensively. That'll be the key to our success as we move forward as well. That's where the game is won or lost, it's usually up inside there."

It seemed like the game had a little more of that, especially early on and your team didn't back down. I know you don't expect them to back down, but in those spots the way they performed in those circumstances with a physical team, trying to take it to you guys and the way your team responded.

"They are an extremely physical team. [49ers head coach] Kyle [Shanahan] does a great job. I think he's one of the best coaches in our league. Our offensive and defensive lines knew it was going to be physical game. They liked to run the ball. I think we held them the 80 or 86 yards rushing. There's some things we can do better that I'll give them credit on. They made some plays down the field on us and we've got to get better with those areas as well."

You guys made a decision to go with G Ike Boettger today, and you mentioned that this offensive line pass blocking was really strong today. What'd you like about this combination and how Ike played today?

"Ike's a tough dude, man. I love him. He comes from a real solid program at Iowa. I just really appreciate the way he's worked since he's gotten here. He hasn't always been a starter. He's been on the bubble, he was here. I think he went to Kansas city and then he was back. He continues to come to work every day with a great attitude and a desire to improve his game. I think he is probably one of the most well-liked guys on our team just because of those unselfish qualities."

With LB Matt Milano, coming back and activating him. How did he make it through the game and what were your impressions of how he played?

"It should be a confidence builder for Matt. I believe he made it through healthy and I think it's been five or six weeks since he's played so it was good to get him out there and get him going again. I really appreciated the way he approached the game as well."

I wanted to ask you about a play that stuck out to me, and that was the crosser by WR Gabriel Davis right before halftime. He has a long way to go and turns that corner to gets out of bounds in time for you all to kick a field goal. Is that the idea of what you're building? This is a rookie with all of that awareness and the ability to pull that off and you get three points at the end of the half because of it

"Yeah, that's spot on, man. I love that level of execution. It's high level stuff right there, especially for a rookie to have that awareness and the wherewithal to know where the clock is in the stadium number one and then know what he's got to do to get out of bounds to kick that field goal."

The country not only got the opportunity tonight to see you guys take care of business against the 49ers, but they also saw Washington beat the Steelers. I know that you had a similar experience when you were with Carolina unbeaten late in the season losing one game. Based on your personal experience, what are your expectations for this upcoming week? With the Steelers perhaps refocusing having suffered their first loss and coming in to face you guys in Orchard Park.

"Every situation is different, but I know having gone through that, I think we got to 14-0 before we lost, it's a hard thing to manage. That's a lot of pressure every week to keep adding wins up. Everyone wants a piece of you at that point. So I can empathize with their situation, that's a hard thing to continue to roll out every week and play at the level that they've been planning at. We're going to get their best. [Steelers Head Coach] Mike Tomlin is one of the greatest coaches in this league. I think he's going to

have them ready to go and I think we've got to be ready. It's probably the best team in the NFL and they're coming to Buffalo and we'll be ready."

Anything special or odd about getting a chance to walk out of Arizona now with a victory after what had happened the week before the Bye?

"I love that. I love that our team can come back here, finish what we started here and finish it the right way. I think in life you've got to be mentally tough, not just in sports, but in life. I thought it took a lot of mental toughness for our guys to not even flinch when they heard the game was going to Arizona and for our entire building to come out here, get this game under our belt and move forward to the Steelers next week."

How much fun was that for you? You had plenty of time, you had the receivers open, it seemed like you were in rhythm, just doing everything you want to do all night. How much fun was that for you?

"It was a great time. Our guys held up blocking all night. Our guys got open, made plays for us and our defense showed out today, too. All around team win and the numbers don't lie, but again, we still left a bunch of meat on the bone. The turnover on downs, the fumble backed up. Like, we've got to find ways to just start faster and finish off those drives. So lots to work on still."

This is the first win for the Bills on Monday night since 1999. I know it's just a stat and most of that you're not responsible for, but as another indication of this franchise moving in the right direction, turning a corner, how much does it mean to you to get that first Monday night win in 20 years?

"I mean, it was just number nine. We understand that there's still four games to be played and we've got to go put our best foot forward this upcoming week. We've got a really tough 11 and 1 Pittsburgh Steelers team coming, so we've got to find a way to, like I said, have a good week of practice and put together a nice game plan."

You guys have had some pretty high scoring games this season. Do you think tonight's game was the best game you guys have had offensively this season and why or why not?

"I mean, it's one of them. We were clicking. It just seemed like our guys were just getting open and the ball was coming off the hand really well. We were protecting well. So, yeah, it was a lot of fun out there, but again, still some mistakes that we can learn to fix. I'm not going to say it was our best game or up there, but it definitely felt good to go out there and play the way we did and come away with win number nine."

WR Stefon Diggs hit 1,000 receiving yards tonight. What was it like watching him hit that mark for the third straight year in a row?

"He's one of the best in the league, if not the best receiver in the league, constantly getting open, making plays. He brings a lot of juice and a lot of energy to our team and we're lucky that he's on our team."

And how have you seen K Tyler Bass grow and develop?

"He's been great for us all year and he works extremely hard at his craft. Kicking's not the easiest thing, but we feel very comfortable with what he's been doing and he's been huge for us when we need to get down there and he's got a big ole leg and he's been great for us. So, we've got to keep that thing rolling."

T Dion Dawkins mentioned that, at least from his perspective, you seem to relish the bigger stage in games like this. Is that accurate and what is it about this type of a stage that maybe makes things different for you?

"I don't really think of it too differently. It's a game. The only really thing that changes for us is scheduling. It was a long day, long day today. We had a walkthrough and just trying to figure out what the best thing to do for your body and your mindset is, and just trying to stay calm and relaxed throughout the day. I know we've got a string here of a couple of more primetime games, so just try to emulate what we did today and roll over it and try to use what we've learned to our benefit."

Is it an opportunity or do you look at it as an opportunity for either yourself or this team to prove things to the outside world that maybe doesn't get a chance to see you as often?

"No, we know who we are on this team. That's really all that matters in my opinion."

To show the poise that you showed in being so efficient, despite things going wrong on the two series, how much more comfortable did you feel back behind center, having played in situations like this before, and how much did you feel that this team and yourself was ready and prepared for this moment and to get over the peaks and valleys of the early going?

"Yeah, we've got a team that care about each other an extreme amount. We practice extremely hard. Really, I think our main goal is not to let each other down. So, when you've got a group of guys willing to do that, it doesn't matter how fast or how slow you start. You always feel like you've got to step in the game and again, it's not starting how we want it to. Between the turnover on downs and the fumble, but we didn't let it phase us. We understood that there was lots of time left in the game and I think the key takeaway from tonight is we stopped ourselves. When we don't do that, when we make a decision, our guys are allowed to go get open, we protect the quarterback and protect the ball for that matter, good things are going to happen."
